- 3. Read Exodus 20:3-5; Deuteronomy 6:13-15; Matthew 4:8-10; and Revelation 13:4-8
  - Write down what these passages say about the worship of idols.
  - What is God's perspective on worshiping other gods or idols?
  - How do these passages compare with the stand taken by Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in Daniel 3?
- 4. Read Psalm 97:6-7; Isaiah 45:22-24; Philippians 2:9-11; and Revelation 5:13-14
  - Write down what these passages teach about God's sovereignty over all nations and rulers.
  - How do these verses deepen your understanding of Nebuchadnezzar's response to the miraculous deliverance in **Daniel 3:28-29**?
