4. In *Daniel 9:5-6*, Daniel acknowledges Israel's failure to listen to the prophets. How does this highlight the importance of listening to God's Word today?

6. Read *Daniel 9:25-27*. How does Jesus' return give you hope in the midst of a culture that's indifferent to or disdaining of God?
